

Greater Gabbard Community Fund

What is the Greater Gabbard Community Fund?

Community grants are intended to help small local groups near to the Greater Gabbard Offshore Wind Farm operation base in Lowestoft, Suffolk. The funds of up to £1,000 can help groups who need small amounts of support to pursue their objectives.

Who can apply?

- The fund is only open to community groups who have a constitution.
- The fund is only open to community groups in Lowestoft and surrounding areas or groups delivering the benefit in (the wards of Carlton & Whitton; Carlton Colville; Gunton & St Margarets; Harbour & Normanston; Kessingland; Kirkley & Pakefield; Lothingland; Oulton Broad).

What can grants be used for?

Community-focused or charitable activities which:

- enhance quality of life for local residents;
- contribute to vibrant, healthy, successful and sustainable communities; and/or
- promote community spirit and encourage community activity

What cannot be supported

- Project which do not support people within Lowestoft and surrounding areas (the wards of (Carlton & Whitton; Carlton Colville; Gunton & St Margarets; Harbour & Normanston; Kessingland; Kirkley & Pakefield; Lothingland; Oulton Broad)
- The advancement of religion or politics (including requests to support the core activities of religious or political groups)
- The purchase of firearms
- Costs of energy consumption (instead we encourage funding to be used to provide energy efficiency measures which help reduce energy consumption)
- The repayment of loans or payment of debts
- Retrospective funding
- Payments towards areas generally understood to be the primary responsibility of statutory authorities
- Anti-wind farm/renewable energy activities, including activities contrary to the interests of Greater Gabbard Offshore Wind Farm and its subsidiaries
